This masterpiece on the shores of Lake Delavan is the perfect place to relax and entertain



/ ith 75 feet of frontage on Lake Delavan, this spacious 4,500-square-foot vacation home was built with lake living in mind. In addition to being the perfect weekend getaway for any family, this home was designed to be the ideal spot for entertaining guests. The two-story shingle-style retreat sleeps up to 17, plus a carriage house for additional guests. "We designed the home around entertaining and the lake," says Scott Stonebreaker, president of Scott Stonebreaker Builders. "We created a nautical feel throughout, with curved windows and walls." The home's open floor plan encourages flow and interaction among guests, but features various private spaces—such as a push door off the main floor den that opens to a hidden office, complete with a porthole window looking out on the lake—so the owners and guests can steal some alone time. The outdoor living areas include a three-season screen porch, a patio with fire pit and hot tub, a covered terrace, and a dock with custom sitting area, making this retreat the optimal place to unwind and enjoy time with friends and family. -C.J.
